Why School-Based Health Care?

To provide quality, reliable health care, reduce absence from school, avoid need of transportation or time off work, improving your child's health and academic performance.

Who Will Be Seeing My Child?

The local Evergreen Family Medicine physicians, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants you know.

Not An Evergreen Patient?

No problem, all students can be seen. Like urgent care, only we come to you.

Who Can Be Seen?

Evergreen offers this service to all students, school staff and employees.



How do visits work?

A nurse is on site at the school. She takes vital signs and can provide lab tests including for Strep throat, Mono, Covid, Urine Analysis and more. Nurse connects with an Evergreen Family Medicine provider through telehealth. That provider can look at child's ears, nose, throat and listen to heart and lungs through special equipment. Prescriptions can be sent to your preferred pharmacy. Parents have the option of joining the visit through their phone. Copy of visit may be sent to your PCP.



Is there a cost to services?

If you have insurance, we bill that. We never ask a student for payment and will see every patient regardless of their ability to pay. If the child does not have coverage, we would offer the parents the free services of our Community Health Workers to assist in finding insurance coverage, often available at no cost.

Immunizations are free with our Vaccines for Children Program.

If you receive a bill call us, and we will take care of it.



Will I know if my child is seen?

Yes, most of the time. Parents will be contacted prior to each visit and offered the option to join in the tele visit remotely.

Exception:

Oregon law allows minors of prescribed ages to seek mental health, drug, or alcohol treatment, report sexual abuse, request birth control information or treatment for sexually transmitted infections.
